December 11, 2002 - La Jolla Valley to Mugu Peak

This is a repeat of my March 20 Hike.

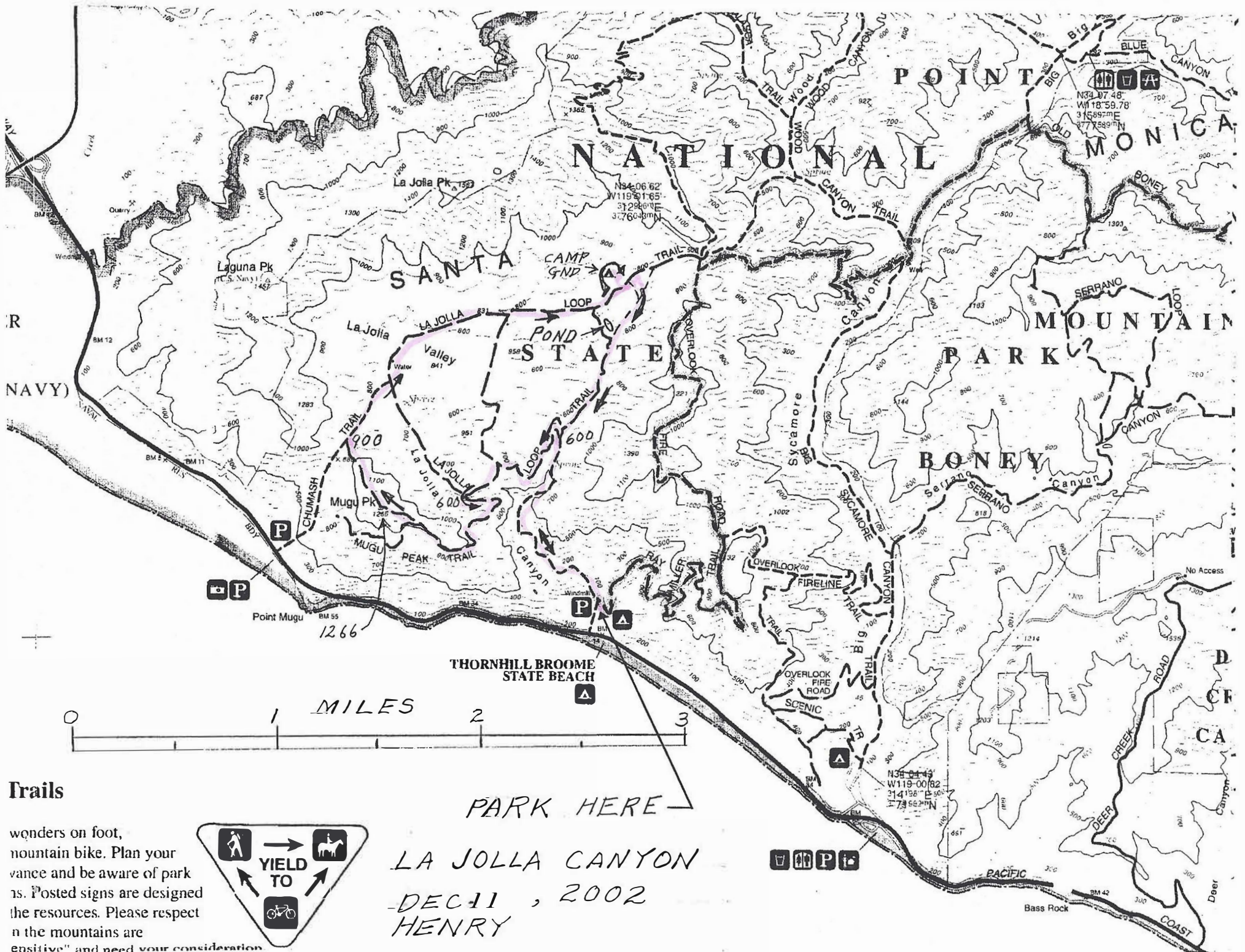
Directions:

La Jolla State Park is approx. 22 miles west of Malibu, 1 mile past the big sand dune. Drive up La Jolla canyon to the Ray Miller trailhead at the parking lot.

The Hike: Starts at 9:30 am

We again start the hike by walking north up the canyon, and across the meadow and then turn left at the oak trees by the old galvanized tank for those who want to take the 6.5 mile loop (this is a good place for cookies). The hike will make a clockwise loop around and/or over Mugu peak at 1266' (lunch). With clear weather we will have a beautiful view of the Pacific Ocean & Point Mugu.

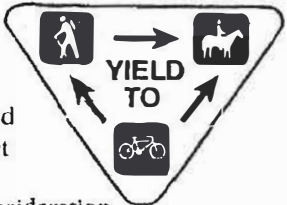
